History

Sainik School Chittorgarh was established on 7th August, 1961 on the pious land replete with laudable tales of romance and chivalry. It is one of the first five Sainik Schools started in various states by the Ministry of Defence, in association with respective state Governments under the aegis of Sainik School Society. The first batch of class XI cadets of this School appeared for Indian School Certificate Examination (ISCE) during 1964 and in 1968, the School changed over its affiliation to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

The School now offers only science stream at the senior secondary level being a feeder institution to NDA. The School is also a member of Indian Public School Conference (IPSC). The 'Vijay Stambh' is the motif on the School crest with the rising sun as backdrop truly signifying School's motto "Dignity & Valour". 'न दैन्यम् न पलायनम्'

Since its founding in 1961, Sainik School in Chittorgarh has established itself as a prestigious institution with a rich legacy. The school is run by the Sainik Schools' Society, which is governed by the Indian Government's Ministry of Defence and is located in the ancient city of Chittorgarh, Rajasthan. It serves as a fully residential English-medium school and is crucial in determining how its students will develop in the future.

Within the nationwide network of Sainik Schools, Chittorgarh's Sainik School, which is affiliated with the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), is particularly noteworthy. The main goal of these institutions is to develop a disciplined, leadership-focused, and patriotic spirit in cadets as they get ready to join the esteemed National Defence Academy (NDA). The school's infrastructure, which spans a vast campus of approximately 272 acres, is evidence of its dedication to offering a setting that is favourable for holistic development. OFFICER LIKE QUALITIES

FACTOR I: PLANNING AND ORGANISING

- EFFECTIVE INTELLIGENCE** : The intelligence utilised in coping with practical situations of varying complexity. It is different from basic intelligence which is the capacity to perceive relations or to do abstract thinking. Intelligence is assessed by the use of intelligence tests. Effective intelligence includes practical intelligence a resourcefulness:
 - Practical intelligence: The capacity to evolve independent solutions of practical problems and situations.
 - Resourcefulness: The capacity to put to use the available means for the desired end. It may be said to contain two factors :-
 - Improvisation of solution and
 - Finding a solution when in a tight corner.
- REASONING ABILITY** : The Ability to grasp the essentials well and to arrive at conclusions by rational thinking Reasoning ability includes receptivity, inquiring attitude, logical reasoning and seeing essentials of problem.
 - Receptivity: The ability to understand and absorb new impressions. It involves interest, attention and grasping power.
 - Inquiring attitude: Healthy curiosity resulting in an urge to increase one's general knowledge and experience life.
 - Logical reasoning: The ability to arrive at conclusion or judgment based strictly on a process of rational thinkin and excluding emotional factors.
 - Seeing essentials of a problem: The ability by which the individual is not only clear in his knowledge of th situation at hand, but also is able to analyse various factor, sift them in order of importance and make best use them towards achieving a solution.
- ORGANISING ABILITY** : The ability to arrange the resources in a systematic way so as to produce effective results. it the competence to put one's resources so as to achieve effective and desired results with economy of time and effort
- POWER OF EXPRESSION** : The ability to put across one's ideas adequately with ease and clarity.

FACTOR II-SOCIAL ADJUSTMENT

- SOCIAL ADAPTABILITY** : The ability of an individual to adapt to the social environment and adjust well with persons and social groups, with special reference to superiors, equals and subordinates. Social adaptability include social intelligence, attitude towards others, tact, and adaptability.
 - Social Intelligence: It is the intellectual ability applied in social field. It is the ability to understand people.
 - Attitude toward others: The ability to put oneself into the other man's position so as to appreciate justifiable difficulties, to enable rendering help in a proper way.
 - Tact: Skillful management of the feeling of the persons dealt with.
 - Adaptability: The ability to adjust to the environment with special reference to the social situations in the environment. When considering service aspect it involves not only resilient nature shown by an accommodation tendency but also keenness and interest in service life.
- COOPERATION** : The attitude of an individual to participate willingly in harmony with others in a group, in achieving the group goal. This implies a belief in the collective effort being more productive than the individual effort. Cooperation includes the element of joint effort and team spirit. Team spirit indicates loyalty to the aims and objects of the group the extent of

subordinating individual aim to the group aim.

7. **SENSE OF RESPONSIBILITY** : It enables a person to be dependable and to willingly discharge his obligations. It includes sense of duty but is much more comprehensive in meaning and scope. Sense of responsibility implies:
- Sense of Duty: Faithfully and firmly doing what one is ordered to do.
 - Discipline: A trained sense of acting strictly in accordance with rules, regulations and conventions. This bar otes development of self control and keeps one within bounds of social and normal standards. Sense of responsibility therefore means:-
 - A thorough understanding of the values of duty, social standard, and of what is required of an individual and then we it his energy and attention of his own accord.
 - Taking initiative and doing one's best, carrying out even unspecified and probably unforeseen dues ations, rather than faithfully carrying out what one is told to do. It demonstrates moral willingness to bear the sequences.

FACTOR III: SOCIAL EFFECTIVENESS

8. **INITIATIVE** .The ability to originate an action in absense of order or a suggestion, to see what needs to be done be enterprising enough to do it. It involves:-
- ability to take the first step.
 - in an unfamiliar situation
 - in the right direction.
 - Sustain it, till the goal is achieved
9. **SELF-CONFIDENCE**. It is the faith in one's ability to meet stressful situations particularly those that are Familiar.
10. **SPEED OF DECISION** . The ability to arrive at workable decisions expeditiously. It comprises:
- The appropriateness of the decision arrived at.
 - The quickness in arriving at the decision.
11. **ABILITY TO INFLUENCE THE GROUP**. The ability which enables an individual to bring about willing effort from the group for achieving the objective sired by him. This influence is the prime cause of cooperative and willing effort of a group towards the achievement of set objective.
12. **LIVELINESS**. The capacity of an individual to keep himself buoyant when facing problems and bring about a weerful atmosphere.

FACTOR IV-DYNAMIC

13. **DETERMINATION**. A sustained effort to achieve objectives in spite of obstacles and set backs. It impledness of purpose, mental concentration and strength of will. It Includes
- Application to work. The capacity of physical application to work.
 - Drive. The inner motive power at the disposal of an individual. It is the capacity to force oneself along when underessure and urgency, towards the achievement of the object. It may inspire energetic action in others lowa me achievement of a common goal.
14. **COURAGE**. The ability to appreciate and take purposive risks willingly. It includes:
- Ability to meet appreciated dangers.
 - Spirit of adventure, an enterprising spirit and willingness or desire to dare or risk a hazard
 - Capacity to keep oneself composed in adverse situations, enabling one to be steady in facing and handling situations.
15. **STAMINA**. The capacity to withstand protracted physical and mental strain. It emphasizes endurance.

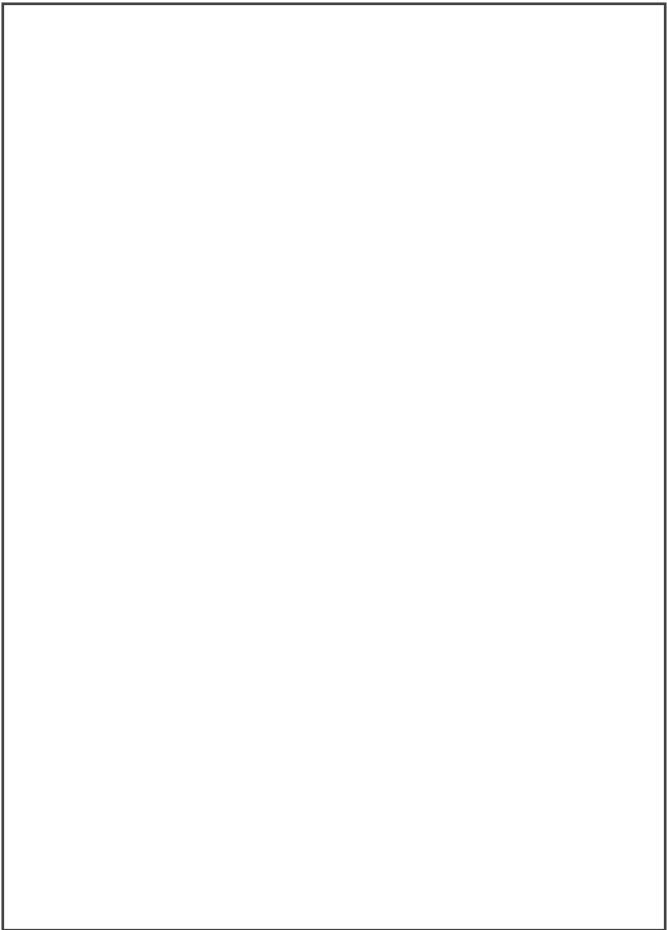
