PARENT-TEACHERS MEET MINUTES

A special PTM to discuss the result of Pre- Board II for the classes X and XII for the academic session 2024-25 was held on **20 Jan 2025** in the Shankar Menon Auditorium at 1000 hrs. It was presided over by **Col ADS Jasrotia, Principal Sainik School Chittorgarh**. The following points were discussed:

Ser	Points	Brief
1.	Welcome address	Mr Rakesh Rampuria, Officiating Senior Master welcomed the parents on behalf of Sainik School Chittorgarh fraternity and highlighted the importance of PTM to discuss their wards progress.
2.	Principal's address	<p>Principal welcomed the parents to Sainik School Chittorgarh. He conveyed the following points-</p> <p>(a) <u>Preparation for Board Exams of class X and XII</u></p> <p>Parents were notified that there is only one month remaining until the Board exams for X and XII, and cadets should focus all their efforts on their studies with complete dedication.</p> <p>(b) <u>Improvement in comparison to Pre Board – I</u></p> <p>Principal stated that after analyzing the result of both the Pre Board I & II improvement has been noticed in the performance of cadets.</p> <p>(c) <u>Weightage of class XII marks in college</u></p> <p>The Principal emphasized that class XII marks are crucial for college admissions and urged cadets to study diligently in order to achieve better scores.</p> <p>(d) <u>Internal marks help in score improvement</u></p> <p>The Principal mentioned that cadets are putting in effort, and progress in their studies has been observed. Additionally, the internal marks submitted by the school, as per their performance, may further contribute to improving their overall percentage.</p> <p>(e) <u>Class XII Students Deliberately Skip Answers, Viewing Exams as Useless</u></p> <p>The Principal informed parents that Class XII students are deliberately leaving answers unanswered, as they consider these exams to be useless. He advised the cadets to study seriously, as these exams are important for evaluation, and without them, they will not be able to assess their progress.</p> <p>(f) <u>Concern Regarding the Physics Subject</u></p> <p>The Principal expressed concern about the Physics subject and mentioned that selective study, individual focus, and revision of important questions would be the new strategy.</p> <p>(g) <u>Commencement of new session.</u></p> <p>The Principal mentioned that Class X cadets will be sent home after their board exams. The new session will commence on 31st March, and all cadets are required to report back on 29th March, irrespective of their board exam results.</p>

Ser	Points	Brief
		<p>(h) <u>Admission process of class XI</u></p> <p>The Principal informed that letter regarding the Class XI admission process has been sent to parents. There are only 40 seats available each for Computer Science and Biology. A date has been provided for subject preference selection, and cadets are required to choose based on their interests. The letter is also available on the school website in Parents corner section & shared by Housemaster in respective Parents WhatsApp Group.</p> <p>(i) <u>Importance of self-realization</u></p> <p>The Principal emphasized that self-realization is essential for cadets. They should view it as a challenge to improve themselves, and by doing so, the overall results of the school will naturally improve.</p>
3.	General question asked by parents	<p>The following points were asked by parents and discussed in the PTM :-</p> <p>Parent of School No. 6045 Cadet Lucky, Sanga House requested not to involve the cadets in co-curricular activities and allow them to focus on their board exams.</p> <p><u>Action Taken:</u> The Principal responded that cadets of Classes X and XII are exempted from all co-curricular activities and are given full time to focus on their studies. However, if a cadet chooses to participate in co-curricular activities and is able to manage a balance between studies and such activities, it is appreciated.</p>
