**VIRTUAL PARENT-TEACHER MEET MINUTES**

1.	Welcome address	<p>Mr Onkar Singh, Senior Master welcomed the parents on behalf of Sainik School Chittorgarh fraternity and highlighted the importance of PTM and the role of parents in the performance of their ward. He informed that this PTM has been scheduled for the parents whose ward has scored less than <b>50% marks in Pre Board I</b>. Parents cooperation is equally important for better results.</p> <p>(b) <u>Information about Pre board II exams</u> In addition to this, parents were informed that from 04 Jan to 16 Jan 2025 Pre Board II will be conducted.</p> <p>(c) <u>Information about PTM after Pre Board II</u> Information regarding PTM after Pre Board II was also given to the parents.</p>
2.	Address by the Principal	<p>Col ADS Jasrotia, Principal Sainik School Chittorgarh addressed the following points:</p> <p>(a) <u>Objective of PTM</u> He stated that the objective of this PTM is to inform parents about the performance of their ward in Pre Board I.</p> <p>(b) <u>Motivation and encouragement from parents side</u> He asked parents to motivate and encourage their wards, as it will be beneficial for them.</p> <p>(c) <u>Information about result sharing</u> Principal informed parents that the score and results of their ward will be shared to them by the house master in the group.</p> <p>(d) <u>Syllabus completion</u> It was informed to the parents that the syllabus was completed well before the commencement of Pre Board I and extra classes were also being conducted.</p>
3.	Points raised by parents	<p>The following points were raised by parents and discussed in the PTM :-</p> <p>(a) <u>School No-5804 Cadet-Gorav- Kumbha House</u> Parent informed that the cadet is facing some problem in Maths. Some chapters should be revised for better understanding.</p> <p><u>Action taken:</u> Principal instructed that devotion is needed from the side of cadet and more focus should</p>

		<p>be laid on self-study and doubt solving.</p> <p>(b) <u>School No. 5812- Cadet Tejas – Pratap House</u> Parent of the cadet demanded for offline mode of PTM.</p> <p><u>Action taken:</u> Principal replied that the second PTM will be offline only. He explained that due to extreme cold and availability of parents, PTM was scheduled online.</p> <p>(c) <u>School No. 5822- Cadet Suraj Singh-Hamir House</u> Parent said that his focus was on preparation of SSB interview. He will perform better in the upcoming exam.</p> <p><u>Action taken:</u> Principal congratulated the parent for short listing of the cadet in NDA written exam and advised the cadet to manage between studies and his interview preparation.</p> <p>(d) <u>School No. 5823- Cadet Nikhil – Pratap House</u> Parent said that they have seniority fever in them which hinders their attention in studies.</p> <p><u>Action taken:</u> Principal replied that they should set an example for their juniors and study well enjoying the privileges of seniority.</p> <p>(e) <u>School No. -5835 Cadet Divanshu Jhahria -Luv House</u> Parent informed that the cadet was focusing on the SSB interview and had promised them to perform better in the upcoming exams.</p> <p><u>Action taken:</u> Principal appreciated the cadet and congratulated parent for his selection in NDA written exam. He also insisted about the need to have balance between SSB and CBSE exams.</p> <p>(f) <u>Some parents raised question as now what should be done to improve the performance from their side.</u></p> <p><u>Action Taken:</u> Principal requested that parents should be in touch with cadet and House Master and encourage their ward to study. Approximate 45 days are left in Board Exams; if the cadet studies properly they can perform well. The Extra and revision classes which are scheduled are for the betterment of the cadet and they should take full benefit of them.</p>
