

**SAINIK SCHOOL CHITTORGARH**  
**PARENT - TEACHER MEET MINUTES**

The online PTM of class X for the academic session 2025-26 was held on 03<sup>rd</sup> January, 2026 in the NDA Hall at 1130 hrs. It was presided by Lt Col Parul Srivastava, Vice Principal, Sainik School Chittorgarh. The following points were discussed:

SER	Points	Brief
1.	Welcome address	Dr Manjit Singh, I/c Exam Cell extended a cordial welcome to all parents and highlighted the importance of PTM and the role of parents in the growth of their ward. He conveyed that 53 parents have attended the PTM and formally commenced the online PTM. Parents were informed that the individual results of the cadets would be shared by the respective House Masters through the House WhatsApp groups, enabling timely perusal and follow-up.
2.	Analysis of Pre- board I examination Result	Dr Manjit Singh presented a comprehensive section-wise performance analysis of Class X in Pre-Board I examination, shared through tabular data as well as graphical representation for clarity and transparency. It was highlighted that, overall, 85% of cadets secured above 70%, reflecting a commendable academic standing at this stage of preparation.
3.	Vice Principal's address	Vice Principal greeted the parents and expressed her gratitude to the parents for joining the online PTM to learn about their ward's progress. Parents were informed that the overall performance of the cadets is satisfactory.  She further stated that special academic reinforcement will be ensured, particularly in Science and English and the subject teachers have been directed to extend focus to slow learners. Parents were also informed that chapter-wise important questions, class tests and remedial classes shall be conducted to consolidate learning, address gaps and further enhance outcomes in the forthcoming Pre-Board II and Board examinations.

No. 6168)- Requested reduction in Class X cadets' involvement in co-curricular activities to ensure adequate preparation time.</li> </ul> <u>Action taken:</u> Parents were informed that only the Inter-House Drill Competition remains to be conducted. Additionally, enhanced study provisions have been made such as morning PT

No. 6195)- Enquired about marks in Pre-Board I. <u>Action taken:</u> The parent was informed that the results would be shared by the House Masters in the respective House WhatsApp group.</li> <li>• Mr Trilok, Father of Cdt Ansh Kumar (Sch. No. 6510)- Requested the result-analysis slides to be shown again due to late joining; also enquired why only a few cadets scored above 90%. <u>Action taken:</u> The parent was informed that the slides would be shared on the House WhatsApp group. It was further conveyed that the results have improved since PA-III and that the papers were intentionally set at a higher level to encourage deeper preparation and stronger performance.</li> <li>• Mr Rajveer, Father of Cdt Abhishek (Sch. No. 6142)- Requested structured doubt-solving sessions for cadets. <u>Action taken:</u> Parents were informed that subject teachers routinely address doubts during regular classes, and further support is extended during morning and evening extra classes as well as preps.</li> <li>• Mrs Sumi, Mother of Cdt Samar Jangir (Sch. No. 6500)-Expressed gratitude to the school administration for conducting the online PTM. <u>Action taken:</u> The parent was thanked for her considerate gesture and encouraging words.</li> <li>• Mr Joshi, Father of Cdt Akshay Joshi (Sch. No. 6569)- Note: Parent's voice was not audible. The parent was informed that the cadet's performance is good and that he is progressing well academically.</li> <li>• Mr Anand, Father of Cdt Abhinav Anand (Sch. No. 6196)- Requested measures to improve performance in Science.</li> </ul>

Vote of Thanks	Vice Principal expressed heartfelt gratitude to all parents who attended the PTM and reiterated the school's commitment to sustained academic support.
