PARENT - TEACHER MEET MINUTES

The online PTM of class XII for the academic session 2025-26 was held on 03rd January, 2026 in the NDA Hall at 1200 hrs. It was presided by Lt Col Parul Srivastava, Vice Principal, Sainik School Chittorgarh. The following points were discussed:

SER	Points	Brief
1.	Welcome address	Dr Manjit Singh, I/c Exam Cell welcomed all the parents on behalf of Sainik School Chittorgarh fraternity and highlighted the importance of PTM and the role of parents in the growth of their ward. He conveyed that 22 parents have attended the PTM.
2.	Vice Principal's address	<p>Vice Principal greeted the parents extending a sincere gratitude to the parents who spared time to attend the online PTM and engage with the school regarding their wards' scholastic progress. However, she recorded her deep concern over the limited participation, noting that only a few parents joined the meeting. She further informed that nearly 95% of cadets had performed unsatisfactorily in the first Pre-Board Examination.</p> <p>Parents were apprised that the examination results would be shared by the House Masters in the respective House WhatsApp groups. They were urged to counsel and motivate their wards to adopt a disciplined study routine and work diligently to enhance performance in the forthcoming Board Examination.</p> <p>The Vice Principal also brought to notice an alarming trend wherein certain cadets were deliberately leaving answer scripts blank and not preparing adequately due to the notion that these marks would not be considered. She clarified that such practices severely impede subject teachers' ability to diagnose learning gaps, identify weak areas and provide targeted academic support for improvement.</p>
3.	Points raised by parents	<p>The following points were raised by parents and discussed in the PTM:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mr Rohit Yadav, Father of Cdt Rajneesh Yadav (Sch. No. 5957)- Enquired why some cadets tend to breach school rules by stepping out of the campus to eat meals. <u>Action taken:</u> It was conveyed that the food served in the Cadets' Mess is wholesome, nutritious and palatable. Despite this, Cdt Rajneesh was found involved in an act of indiscipline. It was further informed that when the cadet's paternal uncle visited the school, he had been duly briefed

		<p>regarding the cadet's academic performance and general conduct. The parent was advised to speak with the House Master and the Vice Principal to obtain a comprehensive update on the cadet's conduct and performance.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mr Virendra Singh, Father of Cdt Madhusudan Singh (Sch. No. 5904)- He sought information regarding his ward's marks. <u>Action taken:</u> The parent was informed that results would be shared by the House Masters in the respective House WhatsApp group. Parents may also directly communicate with the House Master and subject teachers for detailed academic feedback. • Mr Rampal, Father of Cdt Vikash Tholiya (Sch. No. 5858)- He enquired about his ward's conduct, stating that the child's version differed from that of the House Master. He also expressed concern that parents are asked to visit the school at seemingly random intervals. <u>Action taken:</u> The parent was advised to speak telephonically or visit the school to understand his ward's conduct with clarity. He was further informed that parents are called to the school only when directed by the school administration, as and when deemed necessary. • Mr Singhal, Father of Cdt Shrey Singhal (Sch. No. 5962)-expressed gratitude to the school administration for conducting the online PTM. <u>Action taken:</u> The parent was thanked for his considerate gesture and words of gratitude.
4.	Words of gratitude	Vice Principal expressed heartfelt gratitude to all parents who attended the PTM and reiterated the school's commitment to sustained academic support. Parents were earnestly requested to continue guiding and motivating their wards to work diligently so as to achieve better scores in Pre-Board II and the Board Examinations.
